## **Are you living with COPD in Suffolk?**

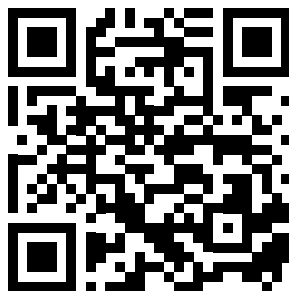
Healthwatch Suffolk is working with Suffolk's Public Health and Communities team to explore people's views.
